UTILIZATION OF INTER- ISLAND FERRIES FROM JANUARY 01 TO JULY 31, 2020

The Management of the Trinidad and Tobago Inter-island Transportation Company Limited (TTIT) advises that for the period 1st January to 31st July 2020, the passenger vessels – T&T Spirit, Jean De La Valette and the Galleons Passage and the cargo vessel - M.V. Cabo Star, transported 244,171 passengers and 89,116 vehicles to/from Tobago.
