The Management of the Trinidad and Tobago Inter-island Transportation Company Limited (TTIT) advises that for the period 1<sup>st</sup> January to 31<sup>st</sup> August 2020, the passenger vessels – T&T Spirit, Jean De La Valette and the Galleons Passage and the cargo vessel - M.V. Cabo Star, transported 281,811 passengers and 104,386 vehicles to/from Tobago.
