### Inter-island Ferry Operations

- Undergo a screening exercise prior to entering our port terminals and ferries.
- Anyone displaying flu like symptoms are not allowed to enter the terminal without proof of medical assessment.
- Wear face masks.
- Wash/sanitize hands prior to entering the terminals.
- Restricted movement during sailings.
