### Update as at 12.00pm, Thursday 25<sup>th</sup> June, 2020 - Interruptions in the Inter-island Ferry Operations

Further to our communication on Wednesday 24<sup>th</sup> June, 2020 the travelling public is advised that, despite the ongoing action by port workers, the Trinidad and Tobago Inter-island Ferries continue to operate as scheduled today, Thursday 25<sup>th</sup> June, 2020 at the following sailing times:

The Jean De La Valette departed Scarborough today, Thursday 25<sup>th</sup> June, 2020 at 8.35am transporting 364 passengers and 103 vehicles; and the Galleons Passage departed POS at 8.30am with 269 passengers and 62 vehicles.
