Update - Interruptions in the Inter-island Ferry Operations

The Board and Management of the Port Authority (PATT)/ Trinidad and Tobago Inter-Island Transportation Co. Ltd (TTIT) are committed to providing a safe and reliable Ferry service between Trinidad and Tobago, and to meeting the legitimate expectations of our passengers, Crew and other Stakeholder groups who depend on the Inter-Island Ferry Services.

Further to our communication of Tuesday 23rd June, 2020 the public is advised that the scheduled sailings of Ferries continue to be impacted by the refusal of some segments of the workforce to accept offered work. This has resulted in the non-sailing of the M.V Cabo Star from POS at 1.00pm today, Wednesday 24th June and the cancellation of the Galleons Passage at 8.00am from POS and 4.00pm from Scarborough. **At present the Management of the Company is engaging with Employees with a view to a resumption of operations in the shortest possible time.**

This company wishes to publicly thank the Trinidad and Tobago Coast Guard for assisting with the berthing/unberthing of the ferries on Tuesday 23rd June, 2020.
