OUR COVID - 19 RESPONSE


The Trinidad and Tobago Inter-island Transportation Company Limited (TTIT), a strategic business unit of the Port Authority of Trinidad and Tobago (PATT), operates three (3) passenger ferries and one (1) cargo ferry between the islands of Trinidad and Tobago.


To ensure continuity of the service during the period of the Pandemic, the following COVID19 Safety Guidelines and Protocols are implemented for employees, the travelling public, customers and other stakeholders, to mitigate the spread of COVID-19.


The Trinidad and Tobago Inter-island Transportation Company Limited (TTIT) has deemed the following measures to be critical to its operations, and as such, these measures are not to be compromised and must be fully adhered to AT ALL TIMES throughout the compound:


 Upon entry into the terminals all employees/stakeholders/visitors must undergo temperature screening.

 Employees/stakeholders/visitors (including drivers of vehicles) will not be allowed to enter the Authority's compound if exhibiting symptoms of flu (fever, coughing, sneezing etc.).

 Upon entry into the terminals, all employees/stakeholders/visitors are required to wash their hands at the wash stations installed at the terminals or use the sanitization stations to sanitize hands (if unable to wash hands). No sanitization, no entry.

 All employees/stakeholders/visitors must wear face masks at all times. No mask, no entry.

 Maintenance of physical distancing. Follow floor distance markers and signage on seats to ensure proper social distance is maintained.

 Daily deep cleaning/sanitizing of terminal buildings and adjoining buildings.

These measures are mandatory and anyone not adhering to same will not be allowed to enter or remain on the Port's Facility.
