The Management of the Trinidad and Tobago Inter-island Transportation Company Limited (TTIT) advises that for the period 1st January to 31st December 2020, the passenger vessels – T&T Spirit, Jean De La Valette and the Galleons Passage and the cargo vessel - Cabo Star, transported 441,165 passengers and 170,421 vehicles to/from Tobago.
