### Update on Interruptions in the Inter-island Ferry Operations - Friday 26<sup>th</sup> June, 2020

The Trinidad and Tobago Inter-island Transportation Company Limited (TTIT) wishes to advise the travelling public that as a direct result of ongoing action by port workers, the T&T Spirit did not sail as scheduled today, Friday 26<sup>th</sup> June, 2020.

The Galleons Passage sailed in place of the T&T Spirit today and departed POS at 8.28am with 318 passengers and 60 vehicles. The Jean de la Valette departed Scarborough at 8.26am with 366 passengers and 120 vehicles.
