Delayed Sailings of the Buccoo Reef from Scarborough – 22 & 23 January, 2022

The Trinidad and Tobago Inter-island Transportation Company Limited (TTIT) wishes to advise the travelling public of the delayed sailing of the Buccoo Reef on Saturday 22nd January, 2022. Due to the late arrival into Port of Spain on said night and the mandatory hours of rest for the vessel's crew, the sailing from Port of Spain on Sunday 23rd January, 2022 was also delayed to depart at 10.30am instead of 9.30am as scheduled.

The public is hereby advised that around 3.20 pm on 22nd January, 2022 an unknown telephone call was made to the Port Security Department in Scarborough advising of "a bomb on the Buccoo Reef," which was expected to sail at 4.00pm.

Immediately upon receipt of this information, in keeping with operating protocols, the TT Police Service and the Fire Services were contacted. Both agencies arrived at the port and carried out the necessary investigations. The Captain, having received the approval by the Officers to sail, set sail at 8.30 pm from the Port of Scarborough, with 245 passengers and 93 vehicles.

The Management of TTIT regrets any inconvenience caused by the above incident. We remain committed to providing this vital service and to ensure the safety of employees and passengers.
