Dry-docking of the Buccoo Reef and Additional Sailings During the Easter Holiday Period

The Management of the Trinidad and Tobago Inter-island Transportation Company Limited (TTIT) wishes to provide the following updates:

1. Update on Dry-docking of the Buccoo Reef

Further to the release dated February 11th, the **Buccoo Reef's** statutory maintenance programme has been rescheduled to April 20, 2022. As such, the vessel will undergo preparatory landside works from March 12th, following which it will resume service by March 21, 2022.

2. Additional Sailings – Easter Holidays

Based on the above-mentioned, additional sailings have been scheduled to satisfy the peak demand associated with the Easter holiday period. To facilitate the added capacity, the schedule has been amended as follows:
