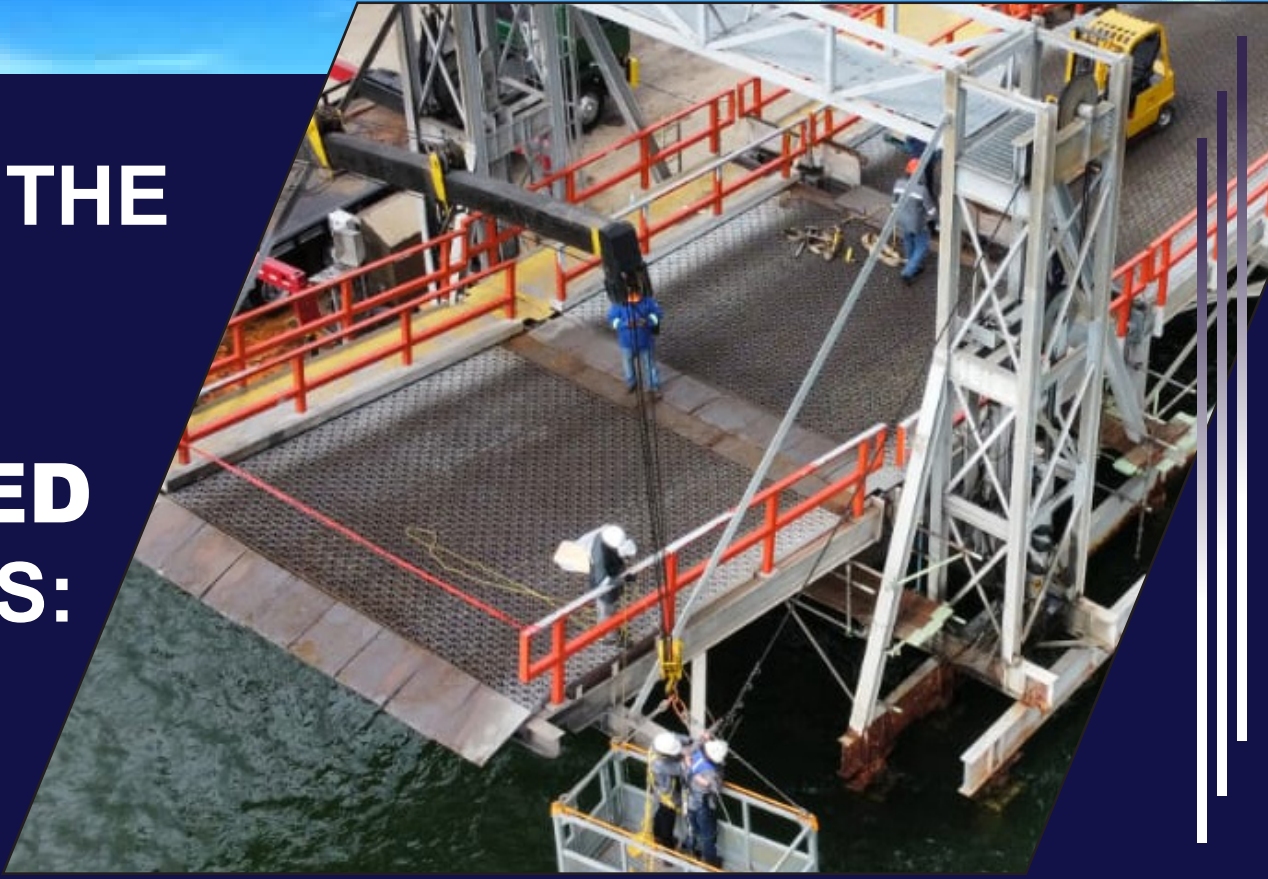




CONTINUATION OF THE PROJECT TO OVERHAUL THE SHORE-BASED FAST FERRY RAMPS: SCARBOROUGH



The Management of Trinidad and Tobago Inter-Island Transportation Co. Ltd wishes to advise the travelling public on the continuation of the project to overhaul the shore-based Fast Ferry Ramps in Port of Spain and Scarborough, by the Canadian based company – Maritime Hydraulics. **These critical works are in keeping with the Manufacturer’s advice and are scheduled to ensure the safety and reliability of the ramps.**

The overhaul of the shore-based ramp at Port of Spain was completed on 15th November, 2022. The repairs of the shore-based ramp in Scarborough, Tobago is now scheduled to be undertaken during the period 28 February – 06 March, 2023 – a period of seven (07) days.

During the period of these works, the Galleons Passage, the Buccoo Reef and the M.V. Cabo Star will service the inter-island seabridge. The public is hereby advised that the A.P.T. James will not be able to sail as the Scarborough shore-based ramp will be inoperable during the works.

In the circumstances, **the Galleons Passage will carry passengers and vehicles, the Buccoo Reef will transport passengers only and the M.V. Cabo Star will transport any additional vehicles, as stated hereunder:**
