#### **Incident onboard the M.V. Cabo Star**

The Management of the Port Authority of Trinidad and Tobago wishes to advise all Truckers and other Port Users that the M.V. Cabo Star arrived at its berth at the Port of Port of Spain around 2.15pm on Saturday 26<sup>th</sup> August, 2023. Upon its arrival into harbour, representatives of the Board and Management met the Captain and crew and from all indications they are in the best of spirits.

The vessel is, at present, undertaking its inspections, re-certifications and repairs prior to resuming its operations. The Management of the Authority wishes to re-iterate that the service will resume only when the vessel has been certified safe to operate and all users will be advised accordingly.

Please be reminded that vehicles with weights up to 7000 kgs will be accommodated on the APT James, Buccoo Reef and the Galleons Passage, based on the availability of space. Priority will be given to foodstuff and other perishables.
