PUBLIC SERVICE ANNOUNCEMENT

Operations of the M.V. Emprendedora from Tuesday 12th September, 2023

The Management of the Trinidad and Tobago Inter-island Transportation Co. Ltd. (TTIT) wishes to advise that the **M.V. Emprendedora** will commence operations on Tuesday 12th September, to replace the M.V. Cabo Star which is undergoing repairs. The Emprendedora will be taking cargoes - building/construction material, trucks, vans, trucks/trailers, containers and other cargoes to and from Tobago. This vessel will take cargo only. Passengers will be accommodated on the passenger ferries.

Sailing Times:

The expected sailing times of the M.V. Emprendedora will be 2.00pm from Port of Spain and about 4.00am the following day from Tobago. These times are likely to change after the sailing time of the vessel is observed and also the loading from Tobago is assessed. Users of the service will be able to purchase their travel ticket utilizing the FRX system for the M.V. Cabo Star.

Loading Operations:

The vessel will be loaded with all categories of cargoes. The process for access to the vessel will remain as is - similar to the M.V. Cabo Star. Truckers/Users will be processed at the GSS Terminals, and await instructions on the Eastern Side of the Terminal- POS or in the vehicle yard - Scarborough, prior to going to the Vessel.

Passenger Ferries:

The normal sailing schedule will apply subject to the following changes:

Tuesday 12th September -

- *A.P.T. James* Departs POS - 4.00PM
- *Galleons Passage* Departs POS -11.00AM Departs TGO - 4.00PM

Wednesday 13th September -

- *A.P.T. James* Departs TGO - 6.30AM Depart POS - 4.00PM
- *Galleons Passage* Departs POS - 10.00 AM Depart TGO - 5.00PM

The Galleons Passage will be removed from service from Thursday 14th to Tuesday 19th September to complete urgent maintenance works.
