## NOTICE TO ALL TRUCKERS AND PORT USERS

### Incident on the M.V. Cabo Star – Tuesday 20<sup>th</sup> August, 2024

The Management of Trinidad and Tobago Inter-Island Transportation Co. Ltd (TTIT) wishes to advise all truckers and Port Users that around 10.24 am on Tuesday 20<sup>th</sup> August, 2024 a minor fire occurred in the auxiliary engine room on the M.V. Cabo Star. Emergency procedures were initiated by the vessel's crew and within a short time the fire was extinguished.

Given the nature of this incident, the vessel will be subject to thorough inspections by the vessel's classification society, which is based in Panama and will require their surveyors to travel to Trinidad for this purpose.

In the circumstances, the daily travel schedule has been amended to include additional sailings **to assist with the cargo requirements**, during the absence of the M.V. Cabo Star:
