**Subject: Removal of All Container Units & Equipment Stored at the Ferry Terminal**

**Reference A.-** Redesign of the Terminal Area and Environs dated 16 September 2024

The M.V. Cabo Star began operating from the Government Shipping Service (GSS) Port of Spain Ferry terminal with effect from Wednesday 6<sup>th</sup> November 2024, and will continue its weekly operations at the Terminal from Mondays to Fridays. During the weekends (Saturdays and Sundays), the vessel will operate at Berth #3, Cruise Ship Complex, Dock Road, Port of Spain.

As outlined in Reference A, the operations of the M.V. Cabo Star at the GSS Port of Spain Terminal required a comprehensive re-design of the terminal area and its environs to include a separate area for (1) passenger operations and (2) cargo operations. Such works included the following:

- a. Reorganization and repurposing of the St. Vincent Street Car Park for passenger operations.
- b. Redesign of the yard space around the terminal building and environs for cargo operations.

In view of the foregoing, to continue the operations of the M.V Cabo Star at the GSS Terminal and to reduce the impact on stakeholders, additional space is required. After completing an extensive assessment, it was determined that all containers and other equipment that are stored at the CARICOM Wharf area will need to be vacated. Further to the previous deadline given, the owners of the containers will now have until **15 November, 2024** to have their items removed from the compound before they are charged for storage until they are removed. In addition, there must be no unauthorized storage or parking of vehicles in the terminals' environs.

The Management regrets any inconvenience caused by the relocation of the Cabo Star and the redesign of the domestic services. These changes are necessary to upgrade the facilities for the overall benefit of all the users of the service. Your understanding and cooperation will be greatly appreciated as we work together to improve the Inter-Island travel experience.
