## PUBLIC SERVICE ANNOUNCEMENT

### REVISED SAILING SCHEDULES – MONDAY 29<sup>TH</sup> & TUESDAY 30<sup>TH</sup> DECEMBER, 2025

The Management of **Trinidad and Tobago Inter-Island Transportation Company Limited (TTIT)** advises the general public that, due to **mechanical issues currently affecting the T&T Spirit**, the vessel has been **temporarily withdrawn from service** to facilitate **urgent repairs**.

As a result, **all scheduled sailings aboard the T&T Spirit are cancelled until further notice**.

The **A.P.T. James** remains **out of service**. In order to ensure continuity of inter-island transportation, the **Buccoo Reef** and **Galleons Passage** will **continue operations with adjusted sailing times** to support ongoing passenger and vehicular movement.

#### Service Update

In light of the above, **amended sailing schedules** will apply on:

- **Monday, 29th December 2025**
- **Tuesday, 30th December 2025**

Members of the public are advised to **pay close attention to official schedule updates**, arrive **ahead of their intended travel times**, and comply with all instructions issued by port and vessel personnel.
